***Equine Embryo Transfer – Flushing & Searching Course***  
***Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018***

Beaufort Embryo Transfer is a specialist embryo transfer centre and aims to encourage vets to use this ever growing technique within their breeding programs. The embryo transfer process has a number of different stages; from AI through to flushing as well as the all-important recipient synchronisation and embryo transfer.

Some veterinary practitioners prefer to refer the donor mare directly to a specialist embryo transfer centre, others will inseminate the donor themselves then send the donor to a specialist centre for the flushing and transfer. Another option is for the practitioner to carry out both the insemination and the flushing, then the recovered embryo is sent to a recipient herd unit for transfer into one of their recipient mares.

***Course Aims***

This course is designed to teach equine practitioners already competent in equine reproduction, how to perform a uterine flushing for embryo recovery, as well as how to search for the flushed embryo and prepare the embryo for chilled transportation. The day will be both theoretical and practical, allowing delegates chance to perform the procedures necessary and discuss the process in depth with the Beaufort Embryo Transfer team.
